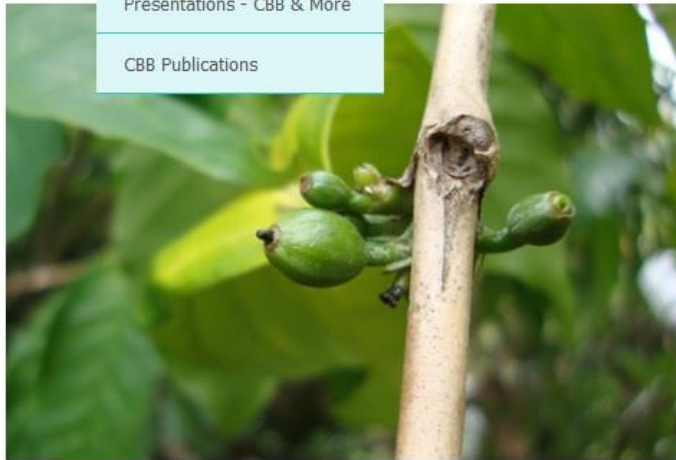

We expect to be funded for 2016 in about February or March, in the meantime, we do still have funding under the 2015 grant and have Botanigard available. Please bring in your 12 Trees form. If you have already strip-picked already, then submit the form with your farm info and CBB percentage from your last round of picking.

We expect the prices of Botanigard and Mycotrol ESO to increase in 2016, unfortunately. The distributor has frozen the cost for several years but that's ending here soon. Coupled with a Matson shipping increase, expect higher prices this year.

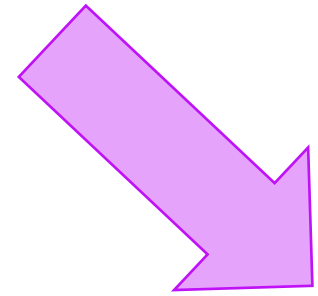
