News release from Dept. of Agriculture

Two coconut rhinoceros beetles (CRB) have been found on Kaua'i, in traps near a green waste transfer station close to the Līhu'e Airport. These are the first detections of CRB (*Oryctes rhinoceros*) outside of O'ahu.On May 31, a survey crew from the Kaua'i Invasive Species Committee (KISC) found a live beetle in one of the traps near the green waste transfer station. On June 2, survey crews found a dead CRB in another trap nearby.
