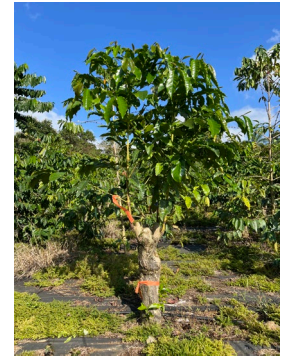


Coffee Pruning and Leaf/Soil Sampling Field Day - Kona

We will discuss and demonstrate selective pruning methods with a focus on block stumping to control CBB and CLR. To help explain the effects of early and late pruning participants will also get to see demo trees that were pruned and stumped in Feb, Mar, Apr, and May 2022 as well as trees stumped in Nov and Dec 2022 and Jan, Feb, Mar, and May 2023.

Coffee leaf and soil sampling will be explained and demonstrated.
