





If you have already strip-picked already, then submit the form with your farm info and CBB percentage from your last round of picking.

Need to join the grant? Four classes are being offered in late January. Sign up here!

We expect the prices of Botanigard and Mycotrol ESO to increase in 2016, unfortunately. The distributor has frozen the cost for several years but that's ending here soon. Coupled with a Matson shipping increase, expect higher prices this year.


