Individual sacks of palletized shipments of coffee must be packed and sealed in one 3 mil plastic bag prior to shipping:	X	
Individual sacks of palletized shipments of coffee must be packed and sealed in two 3 mil plastic bags prior to shipping:		X
Sealed containerized (sea containers) shipments must be individually bagged in two 3 mil plastic bags prior to shipping:		X
Permittee's site must be at least five miles from the nearest commercial coffee planting.		X
Proof of treatment required:	X	
Invoice, packing list, or label listing bag count, name of shipper and permittee accompanying shipment.	X	X
Agriculture inspection and certificate required prior to movement.	X	X
Green coffee beans must be stored in a separate enclosed area away from other green coffee beans at the permittees's site.		X
Used Coffee bags and other associated packing materials must be subjected to a treatment that exterminates any potential CBB after the bag's contents have been roasted.		X
