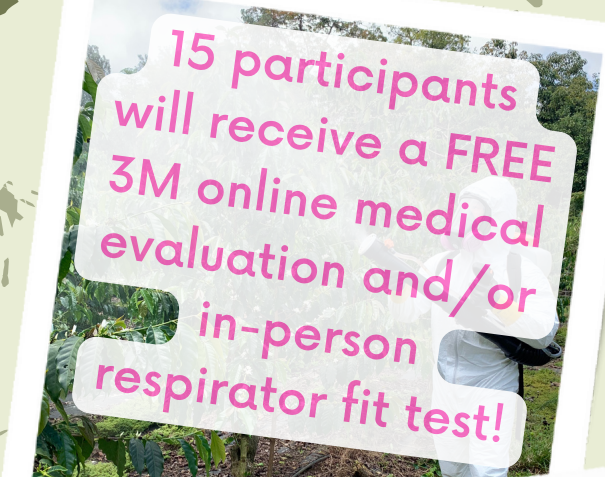

- You must have received in-person OR online respirator use training AND an approved medical evaluation from a medical professional BEFORE a respirator fit test can be performed.
- The hard-copy medical questionnaire form is FREE and available in English and Spanish. Complete the questionnaire and bring it with you to your in-person medical evaluation appointment.
- A 3M online medical evaluation is FREE if you register early.
- A medical professional will be present in Kona to evaluate your hard-copy medical questionnaire form on April 25 or May 16.
- For a respirator fit test, sign-up is required during registration. Instructions will be provided for a fit test at your location.
